Engineer's Opinion of Probable Construction Cost of Combined Projects: \$ 709,900.00

Notice of Award is tentatively expected to be issued at the Township Trustees Meeting on 9/13/2011.

These two projects consist of the removal and replacement of storm sewers on Bathgate, North Watling Way, and Orkney with the necessary pavement and landscaping repairs. Bids will be taken for Project "A" and Project "B", as a combined BID.

Detailed plans and specifications can be seen at the office of the consultant, LDC, Inc., 9025 Osborne Drive, Mentor, OH, 44060, during the weekday office hours of 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. Plans, specifications and bidding blanks may be obtained at the office of the CONSULTANT upon payment of \$65.00 per set (includes both projects), NONE OF WHICH IS REFUNDABLE. Contract Documents may be mailed upon receipt of request, payment, and postage for such contract documents. Checks shall be made payable to LDC, Inc.

Each proposal must be accompanied by an original **Certified Check, Cashiers Check, Money Order**, or an **Irrevocable Letter of Credit** in the amount of **ten percent (10%) of the amount BID** or by a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the amount BID in accordance with Section 1543.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety. Checks, Money Orders, Irrevocable Letter of Credit, or Bonds shall be made payable to the Board of Madison Township Trustees and will be held as a guarantee that in the event the BID is accepted and a contract awarded to the BIDDER, the Contract will be duly executed and its performance properly secured.

Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio Products, materials, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Lake County and Madison Township, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Bureau of Employment Services, Wage and Hour Division, (614) 644-2239

The successful BIDDER will be required to furnish a bond for the faithful performance of the Contract in a sum not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the total price BID for the complete work, said bond to be that of an approved surety company authorized to transact business in the State of Ohio and shall be underwritten by a surety that is listed on the most current Department of the Treasury Circular 570, "Surety Companies Acceptable on Federal Bonds."

Each proposal must be made upon the blanks furnished with the contract drawings and specifications and must be delivered to office of the Clerk, Board of Madison Township Trustees at 2065 Hubbard Road, Madison, Ohio 44057, prior to the date and time specified and shall be marked as follows:
